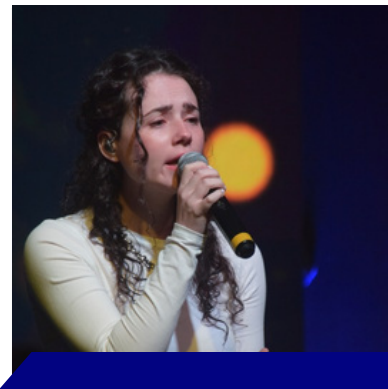
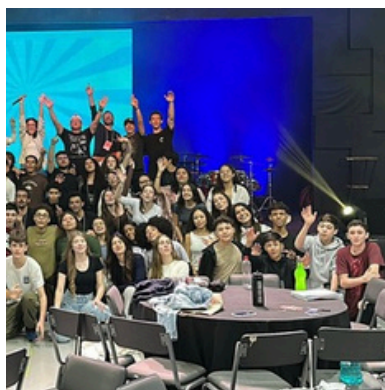
Brazil Target

In June, our team had the privilege of hosting a powerful 4-day event in São Paulo, Brazil, bringing together 300 young leaders hungry to grow and make an impact. It was incredible to see participants from Brazil, the U.S., Germany, South Korea, and Ecuador all uniting for this mission of raising up the next generation.

The team was full of passionate leaders—Ana Luísa, Nicolas, Mariana, Tine, Vitor, and many others representing Brazil, alongside Keith, Ashley, and friends from the U.S. Adina came from Germany, Daniel Her joined from South Korea, and Sergio from Ecuador led us in worship with excellence.

One of the most inspiring moments came from the worship team, who shared how deeply encouraged they felt seeing the energy, passion, and potential of the Brazilian young leaders. Their fire for the Kingdom was contagious, filling every session with hope and excitement for what's ahead.

What an unforgettable gathering in São Paulo! Huge shoutout to everyone who made it possible—you are shaping the future!



Brazil MPC Project

The Next Gen in Schools project expanded this quarter, increasing the number of institutions involved, strengthening the role of school chaplains, and reinforcing partnerships with student councils. The main focus during this period was to prepare for the second semester by consolidating learnings, creating replicable models, and initiating youth leadership engagement.

In total, the project reached six active schools, held eight meetings with student councils, and involved eight chaplains and seven trained mentors, directly impacting 528 students. Activities included strategic school mapping, activation of student councils and mentors, mentoring sessions, and the testing of new support materials to be applied in diverse school contexts.

Key highlights came from several partner schools. At E.E. Vicente Rao (São Paulo/SP), the project was carried out in 16 classrooms, reaching an average of 300 students. At E.E. Parque 120 (Francisco Morato/SP), a chaplain's intervention deeply impacted a student facing emotional vulnerability. E.E. Davina Aguiar (São Paulo/SP) hosted a GLS NextGen activity with over 70 students participating, while E.E. Manuel Vergueiro Lacerda (São Paulo/SP) engaged 80 students in its sessions. Despite notable progress, some challenges remain, such as delays in bureaucratic processes, incomplete chaplain reporting, and difficulty fostering autonomous student leadership.

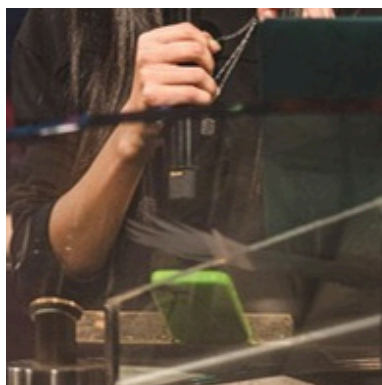
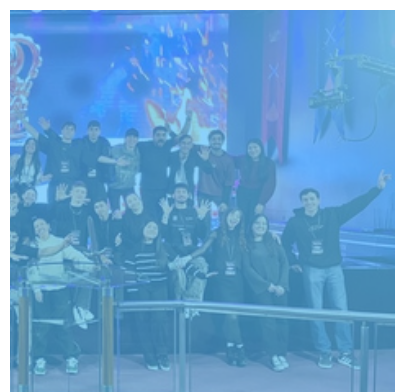
Looking ahead to August and September, priorities include consolidating a step-by-step model for student councils, developing a training pathway for young leaders, strengthening data collection through a standard app, and engaging new schools toward the goal of reaching 20 by September.

Argentina + Ana Luísa

At just 23 years old, Ana Luísa from Brazil is already making a global impact as part of the GLS Next Gen team. In June, while the team was in São Paulo, she traveled to Argentina to speak at the Starlight Conference, where she boldly preached to young leaders and inspired them with her vision for the future. It was a remarkable moment, showing how God is using her voice far beyond her own country.

Soon after returning to Brazil, she continued serving with excellence—joining the operations team and contributing her leadership behind the scenes – AND preached at the conference as well.

Ana's courage and willingness to step out into new places make her a powerful example of the kind of leader rising in the Next Gen movement.



USA - FCA Chicago

The FCA crew pulled off an amazing 7-on-7 football tournament out in West Metro Chicago—an area that can be pretty tough when it comes to crime and challenges young people face.

Around 10 high school teams came ready to compete, splitting into two squads and going at it all morning until the finals.

The energy was high, but what made the biggest impact came after the games. A former NFL player shared a powerful message about where true identity is found—in Christ—and you could see it hit home with so many of the players.

Then FCA surprised everyone with Chick-fil-A for the whole crowd. And get this —God multiplied the food in a real way. Even with all those hungry high school football players and their families there, everyone ate and left full.

It turned into more than just a tournament—it was a chance for a community to come together, for families to be encouraged, and for students to experience God's love in a real, practical way.

FCA is doing incredible work using sports to open doors and change lives in that area and many others.

"I'm pleased to share a brief update on the progress of our outreach efforts here in Nairobi. Through our twice-monthly street worship gatherings, we've reached over 3,000 young people, with attendance steadily growing each time.

We've also held two impactful indoor events, despite limited resources, currently relying on Android phones for documentation.

Looking ahead, we're excited to announce our upcoming Annual Next Gen Event, scheduled for October 26, 2025, which aims to bring together over 1,000 youth for a powerful time of worship, connection, and transformation.

The team is deeply grateful to each of you who has been investing time, energy, and heart into the young generation.

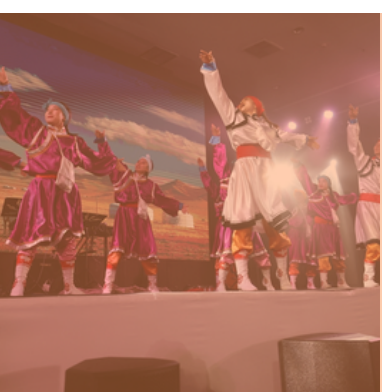


Arise Asia - Partnership
